




# How Satisfied are you with your membership in our Rotary Club?

Overall, how satisfied are you with your membership in our Rotary club? 52 responses










# How Satisfied are you with your membership in our Rotary Club?











How important to you are these items at our club meetings?










How interested are you for these club special events?

I am selective of those events I invite friends to. I probably would not invite anyone to club auction after the last one. However, I would invite friends to fundraising events.


